COUNTY CODE, 1991, SO AS TO RELOCATE THE
ABSENTEE BALLOT PRECINCT FOR
ALL NOVEMBER ELECTIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Southampton County, Virginia that the
Southampton County Code be, and hereby is amended and reordained so as to provide for the
creation of a central absentee ballot precinct for all November elections as follows:

CHAPTER 5
ARTICLE III
PRECINCTS

1 **Sec. 5-16. Enumerated.**

3 (h) Pursuant to Section 24.2-712, Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, there shall be
4 created in Southampton County a Central Absentee Ballot Precinct for all November elections,
5 with the boundaries of the said Precinct to be inclusive of all areas within Southampton County.
6 The polling place for the Central Absentee Ballot Precinct shall be the Southampton County
7 Voter Registrar's Office, ~~22361 Main Street~~ **22305 Main Street**, Courtland, Virginia.

9 This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and its approval
10 under the provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965.
