

17. DISCUSSION REGARDING THE ROOF AT THE FORMER VOTER REGISTRAR'S OFFICE

With the relocation of the Voter Registrar's Office now complete, it's time to turn our attention back to the leaks in her former office.

As you may recall from your discussion at your August 10 retreat, we received competitive quotes for four different options:

1. Replace with architectural shingles - \$12,000
2. Replace with 30 gauge roll tin - \$15,000
3. Replace with pre-engineered standing seam tin - \$21,450
4. Replace with "Snap-Lock" 26 gauge tin - \$25,000

While we have no immediate need for the space, the building will deteriorate rapidly if we continue to ignore the condition of the roof.

There are sufficient funds in the FY 2014 building maintenance budget to replace the roof.

I am seeking your direction on whether (or not) to proceed, and if you choose to proceed, which option you wish to pursue.

MOTION REQUIRED: If the Board is so inclined, a motion is required authorizing replacement of the roof and directing the preferred option.
