Alternate date for the public hearing is February 14, 2013 at the same time.

Find out about the proposed Route 35 Bridge replacement and approach work. The limits of the project are from 0.072 mi West of the Southampton County Line to 0.364 mi West of the Southampton County Line, for a length of approximately 0.29 miles. The amount of time of closure of Route 35 during the construction period is under consideration by VDOT.

Subject: Items from December BOS Meeting

Good afternoon, Jerry. I wanted to apprise you of the following concerns, raised at the Board of Supervisors' December 17 meeting:

1. **Plank Road (Rt. 35) and Farmers Grove (713/647 in Sebrell)** - at the northern end of Farmers Grove at its intersection with Plank Road, there is a large tree limb on the edge of the pavement (one of your folks may have already gotten it, but it was there on December 17);
2. **Cypress Bridge Road (674/672)** - there is an asphalt patch that is substantially worn and in need of some attention;
3. **Sandy Ridge Road/Statesville Road** - shoulders need to be reworked and repaired from tractor-trailer traffic;
4. **Powells Hill Road (667)** - Mr. Faison inquired if "Slow Moving Vehicles" signs could be installed on both ends of the road.
