

**14. CONSIDERATION OF A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY SURPLUS**

Attached for your consideration please find a resolution declaring approximately 295 miscellaneous items surplus, and authorizing them to be listed for sale at GOVDEALS.com, a service available to government agencies to sell surplus items via the Internet. We will establish a "reserve price" at least above the current scrap metal price.

The majority of the items are very large pipe fittings left over from construction of the Courtland Wastewater Treatment Plant in 2010. Department personnel have indicated that they have no use for these items in the foreseeable future.

In addition, there are two old generators that have been cannibalized for parts that they would like to dispose of. A full listing and photographs are attached.

Any items that do not sell will be disposed of in the most cost-effective manner, most likely sold locally as scrap.

**MOTION REQUIRED:**

If the Board is so inclined, a motion is required to adopt the attached resolution.

**Whereas, § 15.2-951, Code of Virginia,** provides broad authority for counties, cities and towns to acquire and dispose of personal property for the purpose of exercising their powers and duties; and

**Whereas,** the following listing of personal property items owned by Southampton County no longer serve any useful purpose.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of Southampton County that the items listed on the attached "Schedule A," pages 1-5, are hereby declared surplus property:

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Department of Utilities is authorized and directed to list this property for sale on GOVDEALS.com and accept the highest bid; and

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Department of Utilities is authorized to dispose of any unsold items in the most cost-effective manner; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the proceeds from the sale of this property shall be deposited in the county Enterprise Fund.


