A. ROUTE 35 BRIDGE OVER THE NOTTOWAY RIVER

B. “WATCH FOR CHILDREN” SIGN REQUEST

In 1997, the Board of Supervisors adopted a policy providing for the installation of “Watch for Children” or “Children at Play” signs in residential areas of 5 or more houses, upon submittal of a petition signed by the respective heads of household.

Attached for your consideration please find a petition submitted by residents of the 28000 and 29000 block of Country Club Road. While the density of development does not meet the stated letter of the policy, Supervisor Edwards has indicated that he believes the request meets the spirit of the policy and has asked that the matter be placed on your agenda for consideration.

C. TUCKER SWAMP ROAD AND THE NEW ROUTE 460
