

11. HAMPTON ROADS REGIONAL WATER SUPPLY PLAN

The Code of Virginia requires each local government to periodically undertake a comprehensive planning process for development and establishment of a water supply plan and submit the plan to the Virginia DEQ.

As a member of the Hampton Roads Planning District Commission, Southampton County has historically met this requirement by participating in the regional water supply planning process. As our Director of Utilities, Julien represents our interest in this regard.

The regional plan has recently been updated and it is necessary for the Board to adopt a resolution approving it. For the sake of brevity, I have not copied the full document – it's 252 pages. I have, however, copied excerpted pages which are specific to Southampton County to give you a good sense of what's in the plan. Basically, it identifies our existing sources of water, quantifies our existing water usage, and projects future demands.
