This is to advise you that we are reducing our fees for unreturned equipment. Below are our pricing changes. These new prices are subject to applicable taxes and fees.

At Charter, containing our programming costs and efficiently managing our operations are critical to our goal to provide our customers with the best value possible. As I'm sure you've seen in news reports, owners of local broadcast TV stations have levied fees on Charter and other video providers for carriage of their local TV stations. Last year, as you may recall, Charter began reflecting these fees as a broadcast TV surcharge in the taxes and fees section of our customers' monthly billing statements. Based on recent increases in pricing from local broadcast TV stations, it is necessary to adjust those fees \$0.18.
