Agriculture

Conducted Hurricane Irene damage assessment for Southampton County crops and livestock

Bi-weekly monitoring of black light traps as part of regional corn earworm survey which provides timely information essential for optimal timing of pesticide applications.

Scouted soybeans and peanuts to determine pest severity as part of an integrated pest management program. Made numerous on farm visits to make peanut disease ID's and cotton defoliation recommendations

Provided materials and assistance to growers and agribusinesses for soil sampling and wheat seed germination tests.

Provided 12 hours of continuing education SHARP logger training for 54 woods workers.

Granulated over 1500 pesticide containers on August 18 and continue to collect containers for the upcoming harvest season.

Conducted tour of Southampton County Agriculture for visiting professors/soil scientists from Senegal
