

**5. APPOINTMENTS****A. SENIOR SERVICES OF SOUTHEASTERN VIRGINIA (SSSEVA)**

As discussed last month, Mr. David Price's term on the SSSEVA Board of Directors will expire at the end of the month and, because he has served three consecutive 2-year terms, must rotate off in accordance with their bylaws.

His successor can be either an elected, or non-elected official. They have indicated to me that a good Board member should first and foremost be a passionate advocate for the elderly that will give unselfishly of their time. The following economic sectors are currently not represented, or under-represented on their board: real estate, food service, hospitality and health care.

Their Board meets collectively 4 times per year in Norfolk and each member is assigned to a committee – some committees meet quarterly and others meet monthly. Accordingly, this appointment will most likely entail 8 to 12 meetings per year.

Supervisor Wyche volunteered to seek a nominee.

**MOTION REQUIRED: A motion is required to make the appointment described above.**

**B. PLANNING COMMISSION**

Chairman Jones' current term on the Planning Commission expires April 30, 2011. Terms are for 4 years. He is eligible for reappointment.

The Planning Commission is comprised of nine members - one from each election district, one from the Board of Supervisors and one at-large.
