Mike:

The following is a schedule that has been established to handle the concerns for the Ivor District. Please tell Mr. West that if he has any concerns do not hesitate to contact me. Also the sign requested by Mr. Wyche for Bryants Church Road has been sent to Traffic Engineering for their review. Normally these reviews take 30 to 45 days. I will keep you informed as I receive information.

- Rte 635 cross drains – there are 5 with issues – we will replace the one at Sterling Johnson's as soon as I get approval by environmental – the balance will be repaired within the next 4 weeks, weather permitting because they do not need a complete replacement.
- Rte 614 site distance/shrubs – mowing has been done – waiting on tree trimmers – should be hear within the next few weeks
- Rte 631 – drainage issue at Gary Cross' – will address in the next two weeks along with some other drainage issues that we have found in his area
- Nancy Cook – hydraulics has started a review – I met with engineer and he has stated that I would have something to look at in the next few weeks.
- School Bus Stop Sign – One Mile Road has been installed
- Rte 620 behind Ivor Furniture – Trash has been removed once, but will keep it on a schedule to review at least once a month.

Good Afternoon Mike,

There are a total of 247.11 miles of roadway adopted in Southampton County, 35.18 on Primary Routes and 211.93 on Secondary Routes, however not all of the groups or individuals that have adopted these routes are currently active. Therefore a lot of these roads are in need of trash pick up. I have sent letters to the groups that are not active and put an ad in the paper asking them to contact me if they are no longer interested, but it wasn't very successful, response was very minimal. I have found over the last 10 years that some of the groups/individuals that choose to sign up do it to get their name on a sign. It is a good program; however it is almost impossible to get everyone to participate like they should.
