

5. APPOINTMENTS**A. LOCAL SESQUICENTENNIAL COMMITTEE**

As you recall, Supervisor Brown was appointed to head up and direct the organization of a local Sesquicentennial committee to participate in the historic commemoration of the 150th anniversary of the American Civil War. He has asked each Board member to assist him by appointing a member from their respective district(s). To date, Richard Francis has been appointed to represent the Boykins-Branchville District, Rod Phelps has been appointed from Franklin, and Jay Felts will represent Jerusalem. We are awaiting appointments from Capron, Berlin-Ivor, Drewryville and Newsoms.

MOTION REQUIRED: A motion is required to appoint a member from the remaining 4 Districts to the local Sesquicentennial Committee.

B. BLACKWATER REGIONAL LIBRARY

Attached for your reference, please find correspondence from Ms. Yvonne Hilliard-Bradley, Library Director, with regard to the upcoming expiration of Mrs. Betty Sue Young's term. Mrs. Young is eligible to serve a second full term, has expressed a willingness to do so, and comes highly recommended from Ms. Hilliard-Bradley.

MOTION REQUIRED: A motion is required to reappoint Mrs. Young to another term on the Board, which will expire on June 30, 2014.

I'm also attaching a letter of resignation recently received from Mrs. Kay N. Pope who was appointed last year. Her term expires June 30, 2013 and the Board will need to identify and appoint a successor. Our third representative on the 15-member Board is Mrs. Bernadette Whitley from Sedley.

C. PAUL D. CAMP COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD

Attached herewith please find correspondence from Dr. Douglas Boyce indicating that the terms of A. Meredith (Mert) Felts and Louis Clayton will expire on June 30, 2010. Based on the organizational bylaws, Mr. Clayton is ineligible for reappointment, having completed two full terms. My records also indicate that Mrs. Kisha Watson's term (appointed in December to complete Mrs. Alice Parker's unexpired term) will also expire on June 30 but, at this writing, I have not confirmed that with Dr. Boyce. Chairman Jones will need to appoint a Board member to identify a successor for Mr. Clayton.

MOTION REQUIRED: If the Board is so inclined, a motion is required to reappoint Mr. A. Meredith Felts to a second consecutive term, expiring June 30, 2014.

D. PLANNING COMMISSION

Please be advised that the following two Commissioner's terms will expire April 30, 2010:

Jerusalem District - Dr. Alan W. Edwards
Boykins-Branchville District - J. Michael Mann

Both men are eligible for reappointment. Terms are for four (4) years.

ACTION REQUIRED: If the Board is so inclined, both men should be contacted to determine their willingness to continue serving. If they're not, potential successors should be identified and contacted by Supervisors Felts and/or Faison. These appointments may be deferred until May, if necessary (members whose terms expire continue to serve until a successor is appointed).
