1 A BILL to amend and reenact § 10.1-414 of the Code of Virginia, relating to designating the Nottoway  
2 River as a scenic river.

3 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

4 **1. That § 10.1-414 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**


5 § 10.1-414. Nottoway State Scenic River.

6 The Nottoway River in Sussex County and Southampton County, from the Route 40 bridge at  
7 Stony Creek to the ~~Careys Bridge at Route 653~~ North Carolina line, a distance of approximately ~~39 1/2~~  
8 72.5 miles, is hereby designated a component of the Virginia Scenic Rivers System.

9 Nothing in this section shall preclude the Commonwealth or a local governing body from  
10 constructing, reconstructing, operating, or performing necessary maintenance on any transportation or  
11 public water supply project.


Enclosed you will find a spreadsheet showing this past year's attendance of the library board representatives from each of the five localities which make up the Blackwater Regional Library system (City of Franklin, Isle of Wight, Southampton, Surry, Sussex).

This information is part of the reporting which is required in the current contract between Blackwater Regional Library and all localities.

The library board of a regional library is considered a "governing" board and therefore has fiscal responsibilities and sets the policies for the system. Representation is determined by a formula which is in the contract. Board members not only attend their monthly meetings but also perform a great deal of work in board committees. There are currently three active committees: Finance, Personnel and Policy and Technology.
