

## 2. HIGHWAY MATTERS

### A. HIGHWAY ABANDONMENT - PORTION OF ROUTE 622 NEAR ZUNI

As you may recall from last month, Supervisor West agreed to contact Gracie B. Waters, et als regarding their willingness to donate the necessary right-of-way at the intersection of Seacock Chapel Road and Tucker Swamp Road in order to improve the turning radius, should the Board ultimately decide to abandon a portion of Route 622.

### B. ROUTE 58 INTERCHANGE FUNDING ELIMINATED

In an effort to address the \$2.6 billion transportation funding shortfall, in a rare mid-year revision, VDOT reduced its highway construction budget by \$2 billion including \$16.5 million that had been allocated to the Route 58 interchange east of Courtland. Inside sources have indicated to me that future funding for that project is highly unlikely given the improvement in motorist safety since the traffic signal was installed last year. I'm meeting with Mr. Lomax and other VDOT staff next Monday afternoon to discuss alternative improvements to the intersection in lieu of a grade-separated interchange.
