

3. HIGHWAY MATTERS

A. HIGHWAY ABANDONMENT - PORTION OF ROUTE 622 NEAR ZUNI

As you may recall from last month, Supervisor West agreed to contact Gracie B. Waters, et als regarding their willingness to donate the necessary right-of-way at the intersection of Seacock Chapel Road and Tucker Swamp Road in order to improve the turning radius, should the Board ultimately decides to abandon a portion of Route 622.

B. RURAL ADDITION – LAUREL STREET (TOWN OF COURTLAND)

You may recall that this was discussed briefly last month – eventually a resolution will be required from the Board, but Mr. Kee has informed me that utility relocation issues must first be resolved by the Town of Courtland – apparently overhead power lines are located in the highway right-of-way and must be relocated before VDOT can consider taking the street into the secondary system.
