

**14. MISCELLANEOUS****A. BYRNE GRANT APPLICATION**

The Sheriff's Office has applied for \$25,114 in federal grant funds through the U.S. Department of Justice for certain equipment purchases to enhance their operations. The purchases would include 20 digital cameras for crime scene photographs, 10 personal video recorders to routinely video traffic stops to provide the courts and prosecutors a clear description of events as they unfold, 20 gun racks to ensure that officer's weapons are secure in their vehicles, 15 push bumpers to allow deputies to clear disable vehicles from the roadway, and various tactical holsters and uniforms for the Critical Response Team. One of the requirements of the grant is for the local governing body to review the grant application. A full copy is available of the grant application is attached for your review.
