This letter is to document the request you made on September 14, 2010 regarding the subject waterworks. During your conversation with me you informed me that you had received the permit revocation letter. You also inquired as to what you needed to do in order to get the permit re-issued to you. I explained that the since the permit is not transferable then the permit would need to be re-issued to you. The waterworks will continue to be regulated by this office as a public waterworks.

We also discussed the need to submit a waterworks permit application. The application can be downloaded from our website at [www.vdh.virginia.gov/drinking\\_water/owners/permit\\_application\\_wbop.htm](http://www.vdh.virginia.gov/drinking_water/owners/permit_application_wbop.htm).

In addition a Waterworks Business Operation Plan is required for any potential waterworks owner if he/she has never owned or operated a public waterworks. Section 32.1-172 of the *Code of Virginia* states that "an application for a permit shall include a comprehensive business plan detailing the technical, managerial, and financial commitments to be made by the owner in order to assure that the waterworks' performance requirements for providing the water supply will be met over the long term". A copy of the plan can be downloaded from the ODW website.

#### **Re: Failure to Collect Required Bacteriological Samples**

Dear Ms. Harper:

This notice is to advise that you may be in violation of §12 VAC 5-590-370 of the Commonwealth of Virginia *Waterworks Regulations* for failure to complete required monitoring of the bacteriological quality of water your waterworks serves to consumers. The *Regulations* require your system to collect one routine water sample for bacteriological examination each month and report the results of the test to this office no later than the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the following month. According to our records no bacteriological sample was collected, analyzed or reported for the month of July 2010.

#### **Required Actions**

**Public Notice:** The *Waterworks Regulations* characterizes this as a situation that requires Tier 3 public notification. According to § 12 VAC 5-590-540, you are required to notify consumers that the prescribed monitoring was not performed, as follows:

- You must provide notice to consumers no later than one year following receipt of this notice.
- Your notice to customers must be mailed or directly delivered to each customer receiving a bill, and to other service connections served by your waterworks.
- If your waterworks serves consumers who do not pay water bills, or do not have service connection addresses (apartment dwellers, university students, or nursing home patients, for example), you must also use other delivery methods to provide notice to these consumers as well. Examples of other methods include (but are not limited to) publication in local newspapers, delivery of multiple copies to apartment buildings, or posting the notice in public places served by the system.

DISCHARGE LOCATION/RECEIVING STREAM/WATERSHED: Southampton County; Meherrin River; Chowan River/Dismal Swamp Basin

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Southampton County has applied for reissuance of a permit for the Boykins Wastewater Treatment Plant in Boykins, Virginia. The applicant proposes to release treated sewage at a rate of 0.590 million gallons per day into a water body. Sludge from the treatment process will be disposed by landfill at the SPSA landfill in Suffolk, Virginia when sludge is generated. The permit will limit the following pollutants to amounts that protect water quality: pH, Biological Oxygen Demand, Total Suspended Solids, Total Residual Chlorine, Dissolved Oxygen, Ammonia-Nitrogen, Total Copper, and Whole Effluent Toxicity.

TO COMMENT TO DEQ: via e-mail, fax or postal mail. You must include your name, address and telephone number plus the names and telephone numbers of any people you represent. DEQ must receive your comments during the comment period.

The public may review permit documents at the Tidewater Regional Office every work day by appointment. You may request a public hearing via e-mail, fax or postal mail during the comment period. Requests for hearings must include the reason for the hearing request, the nature of the issue(s) to be raised in the public hearing, your interest and how the facility affects you. DEQ may hold a public hearing, including another comment period, if public response is significant and there are substantial, disputed issues relevant to the permit.
